This Indenture made this nineteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight  
hundred and twenty six between James H Tucker of the town of Southampton in the County of Southam-  
pton of the first part John R Todd of Isleynight County of the second part and Mortgagor to the  
sum of the sum of £1000 of the third part Whereas the said Mortgagor doth stand bound as security for  
the said James H Tucker in an accommodation note due and made payable to the said Indenture aforesaid to  
the said James H Tucker for the sum of one thousand dollars and to indemnify secure and save from  
the said Mortgagor to Todd from all damage which he may sustain by being bound as security aforesaid  
by the risk and desire of the said James H Tucker now this Indenture therefore witnesseth that  
the said James H Tucker as well indemnification of the premises aforesaid as of one dollar to him in  
hand paid by the said John R Todd the receipt whereof the said James H Tucker doth hereby acknowledge  
that grants bargains and agreements made and by these presents with grant bargain sell and convey unto  
the said John R Todd his heirs and assigns the following land Town Susan Micky and her land  
Rutlin together with one set Complete of New Encyclopaedia 47 volumes and the following pieces  
silver plate less seventeen todds and twenty four tea spoons one fish slice one sugar dish one month pot  
one funnel and three or four more to hold the said negro slaves together with the aforesaid lot of New  
Cyclopaedia and silver plate unto the said John R Todd his heirs and assigns and to be in full  
use and behove forever by most mouthless and the time instant and memory of this Indenture to  
such that of the said James H Tucker his heirs executors and administrators shall pay off and satisfy the aforesaid  
note with all interest which shall accrue thereon instant any loss or damage to the said Mortgagor to the  
his heirs executors and administrators and every thing therein contained is to be known and are of now  
effect but on the contrary of the said James H Tucker shall fail or refuse to pay the sum aforesaid  
interest of any to due on the aforesaid note by reason of death failure or insolvency on the part  
of the said James H Tucker the said Mortgagor to Todd his heirs executors and administrators
