This Indenture made this nineteenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and twenty two between James M Tucker of the Town of Southampton in the County of Southampton
one of the first part John R Todd of Southampton County of the second part and William I Esqrs
of the County of Southampton of the third part Whereas the said William I Esqrs doth stand bound as trustee for
the said James M Tucker in an accommodation note due and payable to the President and directors
of the Farmers Bank of Virginia for the sum of one thousand dollars and its interest due and due forth
the said William I Esqrs from all damages which he may sustain by being bound as aforesaid
being the wish and desire of the said James M Tucker that the said William I Esqrs doth stand bound
the said James M Tucker as well in consideration of the promises aforesaid as of one dollar to him in
hand paid by the said John R Todd the receipt whereof the said James M Tucker doth hereby
hereby grant bargain sell and convey and by these presents with grant bargain sell and convey unto
the said John R Todd his heirs and assigns the following slaves Tinsy Susan Micky and her son
Reuben together with one set of complete of New England spades 47 shovels and the following
silver plate lent seventeen tacks and twenty five two spurs one fish one sugar dish one with pot
one funnel and Thimble To have and to hold the said negro slaves together with the aforesaid set of
Cyclopaedia and silver plate unto the said John R Todd his heirs and assigns and to his poster
such that if the said James M Tucker his heirs or assigns shall pay off and satisfy the aforesaid
note with all interest which shall accrue thereon without any loss or damage to the said William I Esqrs
his heirs or assigns then this Indenture and every thing herein contained is to be void and of no
effect But in the County of the said James M Tucker shall fail or refuse to pay the aforesaid
interest of any due on the aforesaid note by reason of which failure or refusal on the part
of the said James M Tucker the said William I Esqrs doth hereby give and grant unto the said
