This Indenture made this second day of December one thousand eight hundred and twenty two between Lewis C. Triggant of the County of Chulchampton and State of Virginia of the first part James Scott of the said County and State of the second part and James D. Mapensburg of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the third part witnesseth that whereas the said Lewis C. Triggant stands partly indebted by a Note of Hand to the said James Scott on the sum of Twelve hundred and Eighteen dollars and twenty cents current money of the United States of America and whereas for the further assurance of the payment it is agreed by the parties hereto that a Conveyance in Trust shall be made to the said James D. Mapensburg for the benefit of the said James Scott of the sum or the estate aforesaid shall not be producing paid with legal interest thereon or before the first day of March next Next. This Indenture witnesseth that the said Lewis C. Triggant for and in consideration of the premises and for the further sum of One dollar to him or him paid the receipt of which is acknowledged has bargained sold and by these presents doth for himself his heirs Executors and assigns give grant bargain and sell unto the said James D. Mapensburg his heirs and assigns all that plantation tract or parcel of land situate the said Lewis C. Triggant purchased of Allrighton Henry desc. by his wife bearing also equal with thisa present Deed containing by estimate two hundred and twenty one acres be the same more or less and bounded as by the aforesaid Allrighton Henry desc. to the said Lewis C. Triggant is expressed references being thereunto made more fully appear and also all the building water wood advantages and appurtenances to the same in any wise belonging and the various covenants rules and precepts thereof and all the estate right title if any the said Lewis C. Triggant of indebted to the said J. Scott and to hold the above granted and bargained premises with every of the appurtenances unto the said James D. Mapensburg his heirs and assigns in Trust forever And it is hereby declared to be the true intent governing of these presents that if the said Lewis C. Triggant should personally pay unto the said James Scott his heirs or assigns the said sum of Twelve hundred and Eighteen dollars and twenty cents and interest agreeable to the tenor of the said Note of Hand to the said James Scott then the said James D. Mapensburg his heirs and assigns shall have the said land above granted to the sole and proper use and behoof of the said Lewis C. Triggant and the said James D. Mapensburg covenants and agrees with the parties hereto that if the said Lewis C. Triggant his heirs Executors and assigns shall fail to make payment to the said James Scott his heirs or assigns on or before the first day of March next the term due on the Note of Hand aforesaid that then the said James D. Mapensburg his heirs and assigns shall stand seised of the life one mentioned grounds and bargained premises for the purposes aforesaid that is to say for the request of the said James Scott his heirs Executors and assigns to the said James D. Mapensburg his heirs Executors and assigns or either of them shall give ten any note and bill at publick sale the before mentioned tract of land and shall keep the same
