This Indenture made this 2nd day of February on the year Eighteen hundred and twenty three between John Rivers of Southampton
County and State of Virginia of the one part and Settler Williamson of said County of the other part testifying that
Arthur Williamson of said County and State having become the said John Rivers' security to a sum amounting to One
hundred and fifty dollars and the said John Rivers being willing and desirous to secure the said Arthur Williamson as his security
from the payment of the said sum in consideration whereof and moreover for and consideration of the sum of one dollar and half paid
the receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged the said John Rivers hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents
doth give grant bargain and sell County and make over unto the said Settler Williamson his heirs to forever the following property
to wit One Barn Betty Woods Stephen Eliza Henry & have and to hold the said property unto the said Settler Williamson
his heirs to for the express purpose of paying the said Arthur Williamson the sum above intitled and cost above specified in case
the said John Rivers should make default therein it is hereby agreed and declared to be the true intent and meaning of this
Indenture that of the sum sum as above specified to pay said unto the said Settler Williamson with all interest thereon now
before the first day of March next ensuing the date hereof then the said Arthur Williamson shall have full liberty
thereafter when it may suit him the said debt or any part thereof still remaining unpaid to require and compel the said
Settler Williamson to take unto his possession all the property specified in this deed and after deducting the time and
place of sale for at least ten days at three publick places convenient to the residence of the said John Rivers to sell
for ready money all the property contained in this deed or so much as may be sufficient to answer the purpose herein
specified and the said Settler Williamson shall have full power and authority to make over in writing a bill of sale
and title to the purchaser or purchasers of said property and the said John Rivers his heirs and executors shall forever
be estopped from setting up any claim to the same either in law or equity and the money arising from such sale
first to be applied to the payment of said debt and said Settler Williamson with all interest and costs thereon accruing
and the balance of any to be paid out the said John Rivers his heirs and executors to the person or persons entitled to receive
same by the terms of this indenture provided otherwise he doth remember that if the said John Rivers pay the said
sum of money unto all interest and cost therein at any time before the said property be sold in manner aforesaid
first to be applied to the payment of said debt and said Settler Williamson to be void and all right interest and title therein conveyed shall go out
in the said John Rivers his heirs & executors In witness whereof the said parties hath set their hand and affixed
