Tate of the State of Virginia, Sentinels, Giving the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have bargained, sold and quit claim, and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit claim unto the said Alexander T. Tate and to his heirs and assigns forever all my right little interest estate claim and demand both of law and in equity and as well in proportion as in confederacy of in an & all that certain farm or piece of Land situated in the County aforesaid and the County of Edge and bounded by their belonging to the heirs of John Thomas deceased the Marsh Swamp and the lands of Anne Barker and more in proportion of the extent of the Point deceased as aforesaid containing two hundred and fifty five acres more or less with all and singular the foundations and appurtenances thereto belonging And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and assigns to warrant and forever defend the above released premises unto the said Alexander T. Tate his heirs and assigns forever against the claim or claims of any person or persons whatsoever.
