This Indenture made this 13th day of April in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred Thirteen the
 between Sally Broster of the County of Southampton of the one part and Ruffin Hart of the said
 county of the other part witnesseth that the said Sally Broster for and in consideration of the sum
 of one hundred and twenty dollars to her in hand paid or deemed to be paid by the said Ruffin
 Hart at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Sally
 Broster doth hereby acknowledge has bargained and sold and by these presents doth buy
 and sell unto the said Ruffin Hart his heirs and assigns apart of that tract of land
 bounded that John Broster deceased bought of Joseph Summons lying in the County of Southampton
 containing by a late survey sixty seven and a half acres to the same more or less and bounded
 in the following manner to wit Beginning in a small branch at a black Gum in Derry Branch
 this land and running up the said branch a line of marked trees to a poplar on the end of said
 branch South 36° E. 20 pole thence S 45° E 20 pole to a Dogwood a grape vine thence S 52° E 32° pole to a
 little pine a norw corner in old field thence S 48° E 20 to a little pine black gum a norw corner
 on a branch at John Stevens line thence westerly due up the said branch by the main run thereof
 to a small white oak S 47° W 22° poles thence along his line S 52° W 55° poles to a large red oak tree
 at S 70° W 14° poles to a Hickory a corner of Warren and Stephenson line in Stephenson line A 11 M. 50
 poles to a Spanish oak thence S 15° W 37° poles to a Post oak line A 11 68 poles to a red oak corner
 in Stephenson's line and thence S 45° E 7° poles to the first station together with all and singular the
 appurtenances thereto belonging and the reversion and remainder remainder and remainder young
 and other sorts of trees and plants therof to have and to hold the said tract of land with all
 tenements hereditaments and all and singular other the personalty herein before mentioned or intended
 to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of the rights annexed and
 appurtenances unto the said Ruffin Hart his heirs and assigns forever and the said Sally
 Broster for herself and her heirs the said land with all and singular the premises appurten-
 ances before mentioned unto the said Ruffin Hart his heirs and assigns free from the claim of her
 the said Sally Broster and of her heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall
 well and deliberately and forever defend by these presents In witness whereof the said Sally

 hundred and forty three between Thomas W. Bobbitt Esq. of the County of Southampton and
 State of Virginia of the one part and Amelton Jones of the aforesaid County of one of the other parts
 witnesseth that the said Thomas Bobbitt and Amelton Jones be duly executors of the town of the said
 and County dearest Commonwealth to them on hand paid by the said Amelton Jones about
 before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he having acknowledged his bargain and sale
 and by these presents does bargain and sell unto the said Amelton Jones his heirs and assigns a certain tract of
 Land situated lying and being in the County of Southampton containing forty rods in front by two rods deep
 and bounded as follows: Beginning at a tree on Jones line a corner of Westbrook and Jones
 Land thence along the said Jones line to a corner in Stuckeys line then thence along the said
 course of said Westbrook's line to a corner in Roanoke Applegates line thence along the
 said Applegate line to a corner in Henry Applegates line thence along the said Applegate
 line to the aforesaid Westbrook's line and thence along the said line to the beginning
