presents do give grant bargained and sold unto the said Henry P. Gilliam the undivided moiety of that tract of
land situated in the County of Southampton and before which was conveyed to me by Richard Price
by last bearing date the 5th day of April 1822 bounded by lands belonging to the heirs of Peter Price deceased and
containing five hundred and fifty five acres more or less with all and singular the appurtenances and appurte-
nances belonging thereto and to him and his heirs forever And I do hereby deliver the title to the same against myself
who is the and all claiming title under and in me other as it is distinctly understood by the said Gilliam that I only convey
representative such title as I do hereby title of the said land to me from the said Richard Price In testimony whereof I have

Made this 16th day of January in the Year of our Lord One thousand Eight
hundred and forty seven between Thomas Chappelle and his wife Martha of the County of Southampton
and Parish of Stowey of the one part and Amos Drake of the County and parish of the other
part witnesseth that the said Thomas L. Chappelle and his wife Martha for and in consideration of the first and full
sum of thirty Dollars gold and lawful money of Virginia by the said Amos Drake then in hand paid before the
executing and delivery of these presents has receipt whereof the said Thomas L. Chappelle and his wife Martha
doth hereby acknowledge and being urgent and wanting the said Amos Drake his heirs and assigns forever and
thence doth thenceforth fully and entirely satisfy content and paid they the said Thomas L. Chappelle their
wife Martha granted bargained and sold unto the said Amos Drake and to his heirs and assigns forever all that land
whereof the said Amos Drake and to his heirs and assigns forever all that land
and parcels of land part of the said land he now owns the said Thomas L. Chappelle and his wife Martha now
lives in situated lying in the County of Southampton and Parish of Stowey containing by estimation three
acres of land more or less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at corner piece tree on the great road
then running Southwesterly to a corner stone being a square stone with the running down the road
to a corner piece in the middle tree the said branch down the said branch to the beginning corner piece
all timber growing on that tract of land that is in either the branch above mentioned Thomas L.
Chappelle and his wife Martha in and the same manner tract of land and to the said Amos Drake his heirs and
assigns for ever my son John and wife of him the said Amos Drake to him for ever and
against them the said Thomas L. Chappelle and his wife Martha their heirs and assigns executors and administrators
against all and every other person or persons whatsoever claiming any part share and interest and soever it may
be here present in witness whereof the said Thomas L. Chappelle and his wife Martha have hereunto set
their hands and seals the day and year first mentioned signed sealed and delivered in
