and twenty five dollars to me by Henry P. Williams in hand paid have given granted bargained and sold and by these
presents do give grant bargain and sell unto the said Henry P. Williams an undivided moiety of that tract of
Land situated in the County of Southampton and before school was conveyed to me by Richardson Price
by deed bearing date the 5th day of April 1822 bounded by lands belonging to the heirs of John Thomas dec'd and
containing five hundred and fifty five acres more or less with all and singular the appurtenances and appurtenances
thereto belonging the said moiety thereof to him and his heirs forever And I do hereby place the title to the same against myself
and all claiming title under and in virtue of as it is distinctly understood by the said Williams that I only convey
such title as I lawfully own of the said land to the said Richardson Price In testimony whereof I have

Hundred and Twenty seven between Thomas Chappell and his wife Abigail of the County of Southampton
and Parish of St. Mary of the one part and Amos Drake of the County and parish of our Lord of the other
part Witness that the said Thomas L. Chappell and his wife Abigail for and in consideration of the sum and value
sum of thirty dollars good and lawful money of Virginia by the said Amos Drake then in hand paid before the
enrolling and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Thomas L. Chappell and his wife Abigail
well fully acknowledged and acknowledged the said Amos Drake for him and his heirs forever and
thenceforth lawfully and entirely satisfied contents and paid they the said Thomas L. Chappell his
wife Abigail granted bargained and sold released set over delivered and confirmed and by these presents do bargain sell
release set over deliver and confirm unto the said Amos Drake and to his heirs and assigns forever all that tract
and parcel of Land part of the said he now owns the said Thomas L. Chappell and his wife Abigail's now
lives in situ to lying in the County of Southampton and Parish of St. Mary containing by estimation three
acres be there more or less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at corner piece in the great tract
then running between Charles Crook to a corner then being a square square side then running down the road
to a corner piece in John Dyer's line the said Charles Crook down the said branch to the beginning corner piece
all thenceforth running on that tract of land that is or was the land above mentioned Thomas L.
Chappell and his wife Abigail in and the same marriage tract of land and to the said Amos Drake
and to his assigns forever my heirs mine and assigns of them the said Amos Drake for him forever and
against them the said Thomas L. Chappell and his wife Abigail their heirs and assigns forever and
against all and every other person or persons whomsoever claiming any part share and title want and to be set apart
by these presents In testimony whereof the said Thomas L. Chappell and his wife Abigail have hereunto set
