This indenture made this thirteenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty two by and between and amongst Alexander Burtis of Northampton County Virginia of the first part - James Hoggins of the same County of the second part and Abraham Caldwell of the third part witnesseth that whereas the said James Hoggins became security to the said Alexander Burtis in a note executed to Alexander Burtis for the sum of thirty two dollars and 70 cents which note bears date the 1st day of June 1822 and is made payable on or before the 25th day of December ensuing which note the said James Hoggins has since paid off and now hold in his possession And whereas the said James Hoggins is security for the said Alexander Burtis in several other cases that is to wit a forthcoming or delivery bond executed to Thomas Campbell agent of Thomas Cameron for Calvin Edwards which forthcoming or delivery bond hath been forfeited and execution thereupon awarded for 50 cts with legal interest from the fifth day of December 1822 the said bond with costs which are \$8.02 cents also a forthcoming or delivery bond executed to others listing some agents of James Seagrants conditioned to be void upon the delivery of certain property as in the said bond is particularly mentioned which property was taken by the Sheriff to satisfy an execution obtained in the Superior Court of Northampton County against the said Alexander Burtis and Edwin Crockett security for his appearance for the sum of \$50 with interest from 17 September 1821 also paid with costs which are \$8.02 cents which forthcoming or delivery bond hath also been forfeited And whereas the said James Cameron in which suit is commenced in the County Court of Northampton for \$100000 and damages \$10 and whereas the said Alexander Burtis is residing and dwelling as for as in his home lies to undominy and save himself the said James Hoggins for him self and them by having property in a situation to be subject to the payment to him or them if any and all monies which he hath already paid or advanced or which he or they may hereafter be compelled to pay in discharge of any or all of the aforesaid obligations aforesaid And whereas the said Alexander Burtis doth state that the several items of property as his interest disposed over the tract of land on which he now lives containing 400 acres more or less and whereas even this is already conveyed on trust to William Caldwell of the late Nelson County and whereas even this is already conveyed on trust to William Caldwell to secure the following debts A note to Matthew Williams for \$900 and a note to the said William Caldwell for \$17.90 to Samuel Caldwell a note for \$57 and also to indemnify the said Abraham Caldwell and William E. Seagrants who became security for the said A. Burtis for the sum of \$40 all which were more fully appeared by reference to the said first bond which bears date the first day of March 1822 and for the further consideration of one dollar to the said Alexander Burtis in and
