This Indenture made this 15<sup>th</sup> day of May in the year 1823 Between attorney-at-law of the one part and  
William Abbott of the other part both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesseth that the  
said Mary Abbott for and consideration of the sum of one hundred and forty dollars to her whereunto  
by the said William Abbott the receipt whereof the said Mary Abbott acknowledge hath granted bargained sold and conveyed unto  
said William Abbott his heirs and assigns all my right title interest and claim in a certain tract or parcel  
of Land which now appertains to her as her deceased Father John Rockville containing by  
Estimation Eighty four and a half acres to the same more or less lying and being in the County of  
Southampton and Parish of Saint Lukes and bounded as follows on the North and west by the Land  
belonging to the Estate of John Rockville deceased and on the South and east by the Land  
held by the said John Rockville with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said John Rockville  
deceased his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said William Abbott his heirs  
and assigns forever and the said Mary Abbott for herself her heirs Execs and administrators doth hereby covenant &  
agree to and with the said William Abbott for heirs and assigns that she the said Mary Abbott  
and her heirs the said tract of Land with its appurtenances unto him the said William Abbott for heirs  
and assigns against her the said Mary Abbott and her heirs and against all future claimants shall &  
be by these presents warrant and defend in virtue of whereof the said Mary Abbott hath hereunto  
set her hand and seal the day and year above written

This Indenture made this 13<sup>th</sup> day of May on the year of Christ one thousand eight hundred and  
forty three between Cosdy Whiting of the first part Edwin Neal of the second part and Simon Moore  
witnesseth that the said Cosdy Whiting of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesseth that the said Cosdy Whiting  
stands jointly indebted to the said Edwin Neal in the sum of twenty one dollars twenty eight cents by note  
bearing date the day and date above written on demands with interest thereon from the date thereof and the  
said Cosdy Whiting willing and desirous to secure the payment of the sum of money with the  
Interest thereon according to the said Edwin Neal that as well for and consideration of the sum  
aforesaid as for and consideration of the sum of one dollar to him or her paid by the said Simon Moore  
the except whereof the said Cosdy Whiting doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold unto  
these presents with grant Bargain sell alien enforfeft and conform unto the said Simon Moore his heirs  
and assigns forever one particular tract of Land lying in the County of Southampton and Parish of Saint  
Lukes containing or thereabouts there acres more or less being the same wherein the said Cosdy  
Whiting now dwelleth and adjoining Samuel Moore land which is of record in the County Court of Southampton  
which said Land is called and known by the name of Buckland To have and to hold the aforesaid tract  
of Land with all its premises and appurtenances unto the said Simon Moore his heirs and assigns forever  
soverainty upon the except condition that if the said Cosdy Whiting shall die and bequeath or leave  
to be paid unto the said Edwin Neal the aforesaid sum of money one acre and twenty eight cents with the  
legal interest accruing thereon and all cost incurred in drawing and recording this present writing when  
he shall be dead or require then and in that case in what he shall be buried and it is hereby agreed to by the  
parties to these presents that the said Simon Moore may and shall execute a Bill and complaint  
Dated of Release and as all other acts which concern herein in the same may advise fit.
