

The purpose of recovering the said tract of land to the said Coray Whitefield but should the said Coray Whitefield

 the surplus of any pay into the said Coray Whitefield his heirs Executors or adm^r and to further agreed between the parties
 that it may be lawful for the said Coray Whitefield (in case of a sale to execute a full and complete deed of

This Indenture to wit made the 17th day of December in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and
 twenty two between John William Gibson & Richardson and Ellen his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part
 Alexander J. Price of the said County of the second part and William Edward of the aforesaid County of the third
 part Witnesseth that whereas the said John Gibson & Richardson and Ellen his wife are jointly indebted to the said Alex
 ander J. Price by bond bearing date even with these presents which bond is conditioned for the payment of four
 thousand dollars current money Virginia payable on demand two days after date as by the said bond hereunto
 annexed more fully appears and the said John Gibson & Richardson and Ellen his wife being willing
 and desirous to discharge and pay the debt and sum of money aforesaid as well as to secure the better the payment
 thereof to the said Alexander J. Price and the said John Gibson & Richardson and Ellen his wife having a legal right
 the interest and possession of one certain tract of land lying in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows
 To wit three acres Michael Richardson and Benjamin Jones and containing by estimation ten hundred and more or
 less for this Indenture witnesseth that the said John Gibson & Richardson and Ellen his wife in order to discharge and pay the
 debt or sum of money aforesaid and also in consideration of the further sum of one dollar & him or her paid by the said Alex
 ander J. Price at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have
 granted bargained and sold given enfeoffed released and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell
 alien enfeoff release and confirm unto the said William Edward his heirs and assigns forever the above described tract
 of land situated lying and being in the County of Southampton and bounded as aforesaid and do him or her his heirs
 and assigns their heirs and assigns and their assigns and the successors and assigns unto them and their assigns
 thereof and all the estate right title interest claim interest and demand whatsoever of them the said John Gibson
 & Richardson and Ellen his wife both in law and in equity of or to the said land and any part and parcel thereof with
 its appurtenances to have and to hold the tract of land aforesaid with him the said William Edward his heirs his heirs &
 assigns forever on this special trust and confidence however that he the said William Edward his heirs or assigns
 shall at any time within the first and month of January next or at any time thereafter having previously
 advertised time and place of selling the same at some publick place twenty days at least before the sale
 thereof sell and dispose of all or such part of the above described premises as will be sufficient to discharge
 and pay the debt or sum of money aforesaid with the legal interest which may then or thereunto be
