This Indenture made and entered into this fifth day of June in the year one thousand eight
hundred and twenty three between Thomas Jones of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
of the first part and Robert Ricks senior of the second part witnesseth that for and consideration of the
sum of four thousand dollars to me in hand paid by the said Robert Ricks the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged and of one negro boy Austin to me delivered and conveyed by him and of one box and furniture
two trunks and one chest to me delivered by him and conveyed by him and also certain debts and claims which to
said Robert Ricks against me amounting to about the sum of two hundred dollars more or less to me delivered
and released heretofore this Indenture witnesseth that for and consideration of the premises aforesaid in the sum
Thomas Jones have remised released and forever quitclaimed and do by these presents remise release and forever
quit claim unto the said Robert Ricks his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of Land then
I now live for which I have lately instituted suit against the said Robert Ricks in the Superior Court of Law
Court Holden in the former Capitols in the City of Williamsburg also the following Negro tract stolen from
Sue for which I have lately instituted suit against the said Robert Ricks in the Superior Court of Law
Holden in the County of Southampton also Lucy Tidie alias Asenna all the Chick of Hens Cattle Sheep
and four breeding Lambs also all the house hold and Kitchen furniture and all the other property in my possession
not heretofore mentioned except such as is the bona fide property of him the said Thomas Jones he the said Thomas
herein retaining the possession of the said plantation and property that is now or shall be the 25th day of October
next for the purpose of finishing our getting in the growing Crop which said growing crop the said
Thomas is entitled to and all the hogs except their provisions to have and to hold the same together with all
the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said Robert Ricks his heirs and
assigns forever. In witness whereof the Thomas Jones his mark witness did sign his hand and seal the day and
year above written.

This Indenture made the twentieth day of November in the year Eighteen hundred and ten between
Alexander J. Tidle and Elizabeth his wife of Southampton County of the one part and Thomas Riley of
the same County of the other part witnesseth that the said Alexander J. Tidle and Elizabeth his wife in consideration
of the sum of Eight hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Riley have bargained
and sold and by their persons as and each of them doth bargaine and sell unto the said Thomas Riley his heirs
and assigns a certain Print Mill and the Land thereunto belonging to the said and named by
the Land of Francis Riley and William Ladson to have and to hold the mill and land with its works
ments and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold unto
the said Alexander J. Tidle and Elizabeth his wife for themselves and their heirs the said mill with all
and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Thomas Riley his heirs and
assigns free from the claim or claim of them the said Alexander J. Tidle and Elizabeth his wife or either
of them their heirs or either of their heirs are of all and every person or persons whatever shall well and
forever do warrant and defend by these presents In witness whereof the said Alexander J. Tidle and
Elizabeth have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year last above written
