This Indenture made the sixth day of March Eighteen hundred and twenty two between  
Serge Womble and Talley his wife of Southampton County of one part and Shadrach Boykin of the  
aforesaid County of the other part witnesseth that the said Serge Womble and Talley his wife in consideration  
of thirty dollars of Current money of the Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said  
Shadrach Boykin at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof a copy  
acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant unto aforesaid a tract  
unto the said Shadrach Boykin their undivided proportion of acres in the Land formerly belonging to  
Serge Womble deceased Containing mostly six acres more or less together with all the singular houses buildings  
yard gardens orchard &c and the reverence and reverence now and then remaining in those and to hold the  
said undivided proportion of the above named Land with the tenements thereunto and all and singular  
other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and  
parcel thereof with every of their rights to the said Serge Womble and Talley his wife or assigns forever and the said Serge  
Womble and Talley his wife Southampton and their heirs the said parcel of Land with all and singular  
all the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Shadrach Boykin to have and  
to enjoy free from the claim or claims of them the said Serge Womble and Talley his wife or either of  
them their or either of their heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall be or become  
and forever defend by these presents in witness whereof the said Serge Womble and Talley  
his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written
