This Indenture made the sixth day of March Eighteen hundred and twenty two between

eration of many dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said
Shadrach Boyle at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof a having
acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell
unto the said Shadrach Boyle their undivided proportion of dower in the Lands formerly belonging to
Seph Wmble and containing ninety six acres more or less together with all the singular houses building
Yard Vardens orchard &c and the reversion and reversions remainder and remainance therein and to the heirs
said undivided proportion of the above named Lands with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular
other the premises therein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and
parcel thereof with every of their rights to to the said Seph Wmble and Talney his wife and the said Seph
Wmble and Talney his wife for themselves and their heirs the said parcel of Land with all and sing-
ular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Shadrach Boyle his heirs and
assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Seph Wmble and Talney his wife or either of
them their or either of their heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever that unto this mon-
ent and forever defend by these presents In witness whereof the said Seph Wmble and Talney
