 as Trustee of Southampton County of the other part. witnesseth that the said Merit Mr Eley Trustee for and in con-  
 sideration of the sum of One hundred dollars lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Thomas  
 Suckers or before the execution and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has bargained  
 and sold and by these presents doth bargaine and sell unto the said Thomas. And his heirs and assigns forever  
 all the right title and interest as trustee to as above mentioned to a certain tract of Land in the County of  
 Southampton wherein the said Spencer R. Suckers now lies containing by estimation one hundred and  
 Eighty acres to the same more or less and bounded in the following manner. West by the head of about  
 Seven Rods by the Lane of John Vaughan by the land called Fulghams and by Black water River toge-  
 ther with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging and the hereditaments and remains  
 and remains yearly and other rents, issues and profits therefrom and every part and parcel thereof so long as to  
 hold the said Land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular other the premises herein before  
 mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold every part and parcel thereof unto every of their right members  
 and appurtenances unto the said Thomas Suckers his heirs and assigns forever and the said Merit Mr.  
 Eley Trustee to himself and his heirs the said Land with all and singular the premises appur-  
 tenances before mentioned unto the said Thomas Suckers his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of  
 him the said Merit Mr Eley to trustee to his heirs and assigns forever and against all and every person or  
 persons whatsoever claiming by descent or from him as trustee shall use and do moreover and forever defend

 between Jacob Barnes of the County of Southampton in the state of Virginia of the one part. Matthew Tuck of the same County and State  
 of the other part. witnesseth that the said Jacob Barnes being by law entitled to a certain debt created to him by John Barrett of said County and State  
 bearing date the second day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Ninety three which debt  
 aforesaid conveyed to him the said Jacob Barnes in trust a certain parcel of Land situate lying and being in the County aforesaid the boundaries of  
 which will as well appear by reference to the before described deed in trust which conveyance was made for the express purpose of securing debt due  
 owing to Edmon Bratt and Lewis Morris their heirs Executors and administrators or assigns & the said Jacob Barnes in discharge of the duty imposed on

 said parcel of land described and conveys by the aforesaid deed in trust and every part thereof unto him the said Matthew Tuck his heirs and assigns  
 forever and to the said Jacob Barnes trustee as a certain debt hereby mentioned and above the right and title of the said Land against himself and his heirs  
 only in which name he the said Jacob Barnes hath heretofore set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year herein first written
