Newton for and consideration of the sum of one hundred and forty dollars the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have your grantees bargained and sold and as hereby your grand bargain is sold unto Nathaniel Newton all the interest which I have or in right to the land of which my father Bartholemew Newton died possessed or to which he had title the descriptions and boundaries can be seen referred being here to a deed executed to the said Nathaniel Newton by James Newton son of record in the clerk's office of the County Court of Northampton County and the same underwritten eighth part thereof good might and title to which I am want to the said Nathaniel Newton and his heirs forever and the claim of myself and my heirs and against the lawful claims of all others. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 3^d day of June 1793.

This Indenture made and entered into on this day of _____ in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty by and between Benjamin Jordan Joseph Jordan Richard Jordan and Sidney Jordan of the first part and Reuben Whitfield of the second part each and also the above named persons of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia witnesses that for and in consideration of the sum of five certain hundred and fifty the above named Benjamin Jordan by the above named Reuben Whitfield at and before the executing & delivery of these presents the receipt of which is by all of us the first party to this indenture fully acknowledged and consideration of which on and each of us the first party to this Indenture have bargained and sold and so hereby grant bargain and sell unto them the said Reuben Whitfield three certain acres of Land lying and being in the former County of Southampton and bounded as follows to-wit Beginning on the said Reuben Whitfield line at the place where the Popple road is called Cropper said line thence along said road as a north east by corner to the fork of Morris road so called thence along the said Morris road nearly an easterly course to where Isiah Nicks line crosses said road the said road being our road the line between the first and second part to the Indenture thence along the Isiah Nicks line to the said Reuben Whitfield line thence along said Indentured line to the said Popple Road the beginning which line and boundaries as aforesaid shall contain three acres more or less together with all its contents and appurtenances whatsoever to the said three acres of Land in any mode or manner belonging or appertaining to him the said Reuben Whitfield his heirs and assigns forever for him the said Reuben Whitfield his heirs and assigns to have and to hold the before described three acres of Land free from the claims or claims of others of us Benjamin Jordan Joseph Jordan or Rebecca his wife Christian Jordan Richard Jordan and Sidney Jordan or either of us or either of our heirs to have the said Reuben Whitfield his heirs and assigns forever and we the said Benjamin Jordan Joseph Jordan and Rebecca his wife Christian Jordan Richard Jordan and Sidney Jordan do for ourselves forever hereafter renounce and defend the right and title of the said three acres of Land against ourselves and each of our heirs to have the said Reuben Whitfield his heirs and assigns forever In witness whereof we the said Benjamin Jordan Joseph Jordan and Rebecca his wife Christian Jordan Richard Jordan and Sidney Jordan have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals the day and year herein first written Signed sealed acknowledged in presence of _____ Benjamin Jordan
