This Indenture made and entered into the 11th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty three
 by and between Susanna Williams of the first part Benjamin Barnes of the second part and Jacob Barnes of the third
 and last part each party herse of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia Moved the said Susanna Williams
 is justly indebted to the said Jacob Barnes in the sum of sixty three dollars and thirty eight cents appearing by bond as
 well as this Indenture each of even date and the said Susanna Williams being willing and desirous to provide for the
 payment of the said debt from therefore this Indenture witnesseth that for the above consideration and for the further consi-
 deration of one dollar to her the said Susanna Williams on hand paid by the said Benjamin Barnes at or before the ending
 and delivery of these presents the full receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and from which the said Benjamin Barnes
 and all his legal representative are forever released exonerated and discharged have bargained and sold and by this
 presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Benjamin Barnes his heirs and assigns forever as followeth that
 it is to have the said Benjamin Barnes his heirs and assigns forever all the right title interest and estate which she
 the said Susanna Williams have theretofore this or any to the following named property To wit the feather bed
 and furniture two chest three fine tables two wash Stubs two pairs two neggers one cow four sheep one fine
 horse one pair cards two pots one Dutch oven one skillet one pot rack one pewter basin and seven Spind
 three pewter plates eight earthen plates three decanters two Slugs one pair calf wheels one small drive two
 meal stonds one fire one new orange two Gout hoes two hula hoes two new hoes one axed one cor and yecarding one
 Cor and calf one potter to have and to hold the above named property said unto the said Benjamin Barnes
 his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Benjamin Barnes
 his heirs and assigns forever in witness whereof that of the said Susanna Williams her heirs Executors or admors shall well
 and truly pay or cause to be paid the aforesaid sum of sixty three dollars and thirty eight cents on or before the time
 that the may be required to do by the said Jacob Barnes his heirs Executors administrators or assigns and the legal
 interest which shall have accrued thereon and all costs accrued in the execution of this Indenture then this Indenture
 and every thing herein contained shall be void and of none effect and moreover in such event the said Benjⁿ
 Barnes or his heirs admors shall release to the said Susanna Williams her heirs Executors or admors all the
 title hereby Transferred to him by this Indenture but notwithstanding if the said Susanna Williams or one of her
 heirs Executors or administrators shall not pay the aforesaid debt interest and costs as aforesaid at the time of being
 thereto required by the said Jacob Barnes his heirs Executors or assigns then upon the request of the said Jacob
 Barnes his heirs Executors or assigns the said Benjamin Barnes his heirs or admors shall and may dispose of such
 part or all of the above named property at Publick Auction as will be sufficient to raise money to discharge
 the aforesaid debt interest and all costs accruing thereon as aforesaid if surplus money remain after the discharge
 of the debt interest and costs as aforesaid the said Benjamin Barnes his Executors or admors shall pay the same to the said
 Susanna Williams his heirs Executors administrators or assigns and it shall be the duty of the said Benjamin
 Barnes trustee or his Executors or administrators of any one of them to make sale of the above named prop-
 erty formerly advertised such estate sold at then or more suitable places in the aforesaid County of Southampton
 to be sold at some place in the aforesaid County not less than ten days and ending the fourth day such advertise-
 ment in which shall be the parties herse have herse subscribed our names and offered on the day
