This Indenture made and entered into this 15<sup>th</sup> day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty three  
 by and between Susanna Williams of the first part Benjamin Barnes of the second part and Jacob Barnes of the third  
 and last part each party herof of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia Whereas the said Susanna Williams  
 is presently indebted to the said Jacob Barnes in the sum of forty dollars and twenty eight cents appearing by bond and  
 note as this Indenture make of even date and the said Susanna Williams being willing and desirous to afford security the  
 payment of the said debt for thonghout this Indenture witnesseth that for the above Consideration and for the further Considera-  
 tion of one dollar to her the said Susanna Williams on hand paid by the said Benjamin Barnes to witness before the concluding  
 and delivery of these presents the full receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and from which the said Benjamin Barnes  
 and all his legal representatives are forever released enunciated and discharged have bargained and sold and by these  
 presents do grant bargaine and sell unto the said Benjamin Barnes his heirs and assigns forever all the right title interest and estate which she  
 the said Susanna Williams her Testator has or has in the following named property to wit the feather bed  
 and furniture two chest three pincushions the wash tub the pail the meggen one cow four sheep on spair time  
 two pair caras the pots one dulcet one kettle one pan the bacon and seven pounds  
 These presents states Eight earthen plates three decanters two Jugs one pair cast ironheats one metal slice two  
 meal stands one fire one iron wedge two Club maces two hick hoes two axes one cor and yearling one  
 Cow and Calf one pitchfork to have and to hold the above named property and every part thereof unto him the  
 said Benjamin Barnes his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoef of him the said Benjamin Barnes  
 his heirs and assigns forever entitl'd now heretofore that of the said Susanna Williams her heirs Earth or adm'r shall well  
 and truly pay or cause to be paid the aforesaid sum of sixty three dollars and twenty eight cents or more before the time  
 that she may be required to do by the said Jacob Barnes his heirs Executors administrators or assigns and the legal  
 interest which shall have accrued theron and all costs occuring in the execution of this indenture than this indenture  
 and every thing herein contained shall be void and of no effect and moreover in such event the said Henry A.  
 Barnes or his heirs adm'r shall release to the said Susanna Williams her heirs Earth or adm'r or administrators all the  
 title hereby transferred to him by this Indenture but notwithstanding of the said Susanna Williams for one of her  
 her heirs Executors or administrators shall not pay the aforesaid debt interest and cost as aforesaid at the time of long  
 Thirst required by the said Jacob Barnes his heirs Earth or adm'r or assigns than upon the request of the said Jacob  
 Barnes his heirs Earth or adm'r or assigns the said Benjamin Barnes his heirs or adm'r shall and may dispose of lands  
 past or all of the above named property at Publick Auction as well be sufficient to raise money to discharge  
 the aforesaid debt interest and all costs according thereto as aforesaid of surplus money remain after the discharge  
 of the debt interest and costs as aforesaid the said Benjamin Barnes his Earth or adm'r shall pay the same to the said  
 Susanna Williams his heirs Executors administrators or assigns and it shall be the duty of the said Benjamin  
 Barnes Executor or his Executors or administrators of any one of them to request to make sale of the above named prop-  
 erty previously to advertise such intented sale at thre or more publick sales in the aforesaid County of Southampton  
 to be sold at some place in the aforesaid County not less than ten days next ensuing the posting up such advertisement  
 in writing whereof me the parties hereto have herte subscrive our names and affix our seals the day &
