

from the said Benjamin C Hancock to the said John Mughart by bond bearing date the 17th day of April one thousand eight hundred and twenty three as well as all other monies which may be due and owing from the said Benjamin C Hancock to the said John Mughart by means of any dealings transfers of debt or paper whatever as also for and in consideration of one dollar to him on hand paid by the said Walter G Brattle the receipt whereof the said Benjamin C Hancock doth hereby acknowledge full payment, large and small and by these presents doth hereby grant bargain and sell convey and make over unto the said Walter G Brattle and his heirs forever all his right and interest in the following property least five negroes Dabell Nedney Partanna Seomy and Jacke belonging to him the said Benjamin C Hancock to have and to hold with all the right and interest of the said Benjamin C Hancock herein contained or intended to be conveyed to him the said Walter G Brattle for him and assigns forever upon this special trust notwithstanding that the said Walter G Brattle upon being thereto required by the aforesaid John Mughart shall proceed to sell all the right and interest of the said Benjamin C Hancock to the above named hereby conveying or intends to be conveyed after advertising the time and place in the said County of Southampton for ten days previous at some publick house or store for cash and out of the money arising of and from the sale first pay and satisfy all cost attending the said sale as well as the expenses attending the said conveyance and then pay off the said aforesaid with interest as well as all other monies which may appear to be due and owing from the said Benjamin C Hancock to the said John Mughart by means of any dealings transfers of debt or paper whatsoever and the surplus of any pay to the said Benjamin C Hancock and the said Benjamin C Hancock for himself and his heirs to have the right and title of the said property unto the said Walter G Brattle his heirs and assigns forever with hereby warrant and defend against the law full claim or claims of him the said Benjamin C Hancock his heirs and executors and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever are the said Walter G Brattle on his part covenants and agrees that he will make sale of the right and interest hereby conveyed for the best price he can obtain for the same after advertising the time and place for ten days previous at some publick house or store in the said County and with the monies arising from the sale first pay and satisfy all cost attending the same as well as the expenses attending this conveyance and then pay off the aforesaid bond and interest as well as all other monies which may appear to the said Walter G Brattle to be justly due and owing from the said Benjamin C Hancock to the said John Mughart by means of any dealings transfers of debt or paper whatsoever and then pay the surplus of any to the said Benjamin C Hancock and the said Walter G Brattle on his part covenants and agrees that he will release the said Benjamin C Hancock from the obligation of the amounts advanced upon the said Benjamin C Hancock paying the amount of the aforesaid bond with interest as well as all other monies which may be due and owing to him from the said Benjamin C Hancock by means of any dealings transfers of debt or paper whatsoever for witness whereof the parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written
