

This Indenture made this 21st day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty between Edwards Butts and Mary Jones of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Anthony Worden of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said Anthony Worden by his deed dated the 23 day of July 1822 and admitted to record in the Clerk's Office of the County Court of Southampton on the 24th day of July 1822 in order to secure the payment at the time specified of the sum of seven hundred and twenty dollars due and payable on the day of 1823 owing by him the said Anthony Worden to the said Mary Jones conveyed in trust to the said Edwards Butts all his the said Anthony Worden's right title claim interest and demand that he has in or on the tract of land situate in his name and the said sum before five and two hundred dollars with all interest accruing thereon and also all costs and charges attending the same having been fully paid by the said Anthony Worden and hath request that the Estate conveyed by the said deed of trust to them the said Edwards Butts and Mary Jones And in the said deed made be released to them the said Anthony Worden This Indenture therefore Witnesseth that for and consideration of the premises and also for the consideration of the premises and also for and consideration of One dollar by the said Anthony Worden to the said Edwards Butts and Mary Jones in hand paid before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Edwards Butts and Mary Jones with the consent of the said Mary Jones signify by his being a party hereto have granted promised released and forever quit claimed and by these presents do fully release release grant promise to release and forever quit claim unto the said Anthony Worden his heirs and assigns forever all the estate right title interest property claim and demand whatsoever in Law or equity of them and each of them the said Edwards Butts and Mary Jones of or on and to the aforesaid land with the appurtenances To have and to hold the aforesaid land and its appurtenances to the said Anthony Worden his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Anthony Worden he him and assigns forever so that the said Edwards Butts and Mary Jones nor either of them nor either of their heirs nor any other person whatever claiming under them or either of them shall by any means or means hereafter have or claim challenge or demand any Estate right title or interest of or on or to the said premises or any part or parcel thereof but from all and every action for the recovery thereof and from all and every Estate right title interest or demand of or on or to the said premises or any part thereof they as every of them shall be utterly excluded and barred forever by these presents In witness whereof the parties of the first part by these presents have thrust set their hands and seals the day and year herein first written signed sealed and acknowledged

This Indenture made this twentieth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty three between Isaac Readall and Harriet Readall his wife formerly Harriet Corbett wife of the County of Sussex in the State of Virginia of the one part and John Archibald of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said Isaac Readall and Harriet Readall his wife formerly Harriet Corbett in consideration of a certain sum of money received as well as a certain sum of money of the United States to have in hand paid by the said John Archibald at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said John Archibald his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation money acres is the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning in the back home swamp at the junction of the Oakley branch stream to a hickory tree on the edge of the lot bounded on Dr. Sam and Richard and then along the edge of the lot bounded above the Backhorn Swamp to the mouth of the Spring Branch thence down the various courses of the edge of the lot bounded to the high water mark of said Backhorn Swamp to the mouth of the Cedar branch thence the Marshall
