

This Indenture made this 25<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and forty two by Edward  
 Edwards Butts and Mary Jones of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Anthony  
 Woodard of the County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said Anthony Woodard by  
 his deed dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of July 1832 and admitted to record in the Clerks office of the County Court of Southampton  
 upon the 24<sup>th</sup> day of July 1832 in order to secure the payment at the time specified of the sum herein before two hundred  
 and six dollars due and payable on the day of 1833 owing by him the said Anthony Woodard to the said  
 Mary Jones conveyed in trust to the said Edwards Butts all his the said Anthony Woodards right title claim  
 interest and demand that he has now or the tract of Land wherein he now resides and the said sum between  
 five and six hundred dollars with all costs and expenses and also all costs and charges attending the same having  
 been fully paid by the said Anthony Woodard hath requested that the Estate conveyed by the said Deed of  
 Trust to him the said Edwards Butts and Mary Jones in the said Land may be released to him the said  
 Anthony Woodard this Indenture therefore witnesseth that for and consideration of the premises and also for  
 in consideration of the promises and also for and consideration of one dollar by the said Anthony Woodard to the  
 said Edwards Butts and Mary Jones in hand paid before the execution and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof  
 is hereby acknowledged by the said Edwards Butts and Mary Jones with the consent of the said Mary Jones signifies by  
 his hand a party hereto have granted remise release and forever quit claimed and by these presents do fully fully grant  
 remise release and forever quit claim unto the said Anthony Woodard his heirs and assigns forever all the estate right  
 title interest property claim and demand whatsoever in Land or equity of them are each of them the said Edwards Butts  
 and Mary Jones of an end to the aforesaid Land with the appurtenances to have and to hold the aforesaid Land and  
 its appurtenances to the said Anthony Woodard his heirs and assigns to the myfier and after birth of the said  
 Anthony Woodard his heirs and assigns forever so that the said Edwards Butts and Mary Jones or either of them or either of  
 their heirs nor any other person or persons claiming under them or either of them shall by any means hereafter have or claim  
 challenged or demand any Estate right title or interest of or on or to the said premises or any part or parcel thereof but from all  
 and every action for the recovery thereof and from all and every Estate right title interest or demand of or on or to the said  
 premises or any part thereof they are wary of whom shall be attorney excluded and barred forever by these presents

 and year above written sealed with lead and witnesses as aforesaid

This Indenture made this seventeenth day of March in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand Eight  
 hundred and forty three between Isaac Bendall and Harriet Bendall his wife formerly Harriet Richardson  
 of the County of Sussex in the State of Virginia on the one part and Gideon Richardson of the County of Southampton  
 in the State of Virginia on the other part witnesseth that the said Isaac Bendall and Harriet Bendall his  
 wife formerly Harriet Richardson in consideration of wages received as well as aollar of Lawfull money of  
 the United States to them in hand paid by the said Gideon Richardson at or before the making and delivery of these  
 presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell  
 unto the said Gideon Richardson his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the  
 County of Southampton containing by estimation money acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit  
 Beginning in the bed of a stream at the junction of the Ditchy branch thereof to a tree on the edge of the  
 stream in Dr. Samuels Blunts land thence along the edge of the low ground down the Buckhorn swamp to the  
 mouth of the Brandy Branch thence down the various courses of the edge of the low ground to the  
 high water mark of said Buckhorn swamp to the mouth of the Cuckoo branch from the same the marsh
