 Thompson on the South by the Common branch on the West by the land of
 John Shields on the North and by the lands of Enoch A. Branch on the East which tract or parcel of Land is
 purchased of John Shields together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging and the sum-
 mer and various remainder and remainder of grass and other sward grass and prospects thereof and of any
