This Indenture made this 13th day of June in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and thirty
four between Moorsom Windham of the County of Southampton of the one part and Benjamin Drew of the
County of the other part witnesseth that the said Moorsom Windham for and in consideration of the sum of
one hundred and forty four dollars to her in hand paid or to be paid by the said Benjamin Drew also
before the concluding and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Moorsom Windham doth hereby
acknowledges have bargained and sold and by these presents sold bargain and sold unto the said Benjamin Drew
his heirs and assigns all that tract and parcel of Land lying and being in Southampton County
containing by a late survey forty eight acres to the same more or less and bounded in the following manner
to west by the lands of Richard Stephenson on the south by the Cowes branch on the east by the land of
John Shilds on the south and by the lands of Edmund et Roach on the east which tract or parcel of land
purchased of John Shilds together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging and the same
to have and to hold the said tract of land with the premises heretofore and as
and singular other the promises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every
part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said Benjamin Drew
his heirs and assigns forever and the said Moorsom Windham for herself and her heirs the said
land with all and singular the promises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Benjamin Drew
his heirs and assigns free from the claim of her the said Moorsom Windham to her heirs and of cleaving
from or from person whomsoever shall rise and do warrant and from henceforth to let and to have along the
Moorsom Windham her heirs and assigns set her hands and seal the say day and year first above written
