This Indenture made and entered into on this 17th day of November in the year of our Lord 1733 Between Abijah Jackson Esq; Jackson's Heir & Heir's Son; Samuel Daughtrey and Common Daughtrey of the one part and Reubin Whitfield of the other part each in alone parties of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia at or about 1794 execute to John Jackson a bond for the sum of seven hundred pounds Current money of Virginia with this condition that if the said Jordan die during his life the said John Jackson or his heirs a lawful title to them certain acres of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and adjoining the lands of the said John Jackson the boundaries of said Land being well known to the parties to wit Benjamin Jordan and John Jackson as well as sundry other persons know the first above named party to this Indenture do for and in consideration of the sum of seven dollars and fifty cents to Abijah Jackson in his hand paid seven dollars and fifty cents to Heitor Daughtrey in his hand paid two dollars and fifty cents to Samuel Daughtrey in his hand paid two dollars and fifty cents to Lawrence Daughtrey in his hand paid by the said Reubin Whitfield at and before the executing of delivery of these presents the said receipt or more of us hereby acknowledge us and each of us the first party to this Indenture have granted bargain'd and sold and to buy these presents grant bargain and sell unto from the said Reubin Whitfield all the right title interest and Estate which we and each of us have in and to the said Bond on this condition thereof whether the said bond be forfeited or not in every way and manner whatsoever belonging or appertaining to the said Bond and the final result thereof to know the said Reubin Whitfield his heirs and assigns forever and us the said Abijah Jackson Esq; Jackson's Heir & Heir's Son; Samuel Daughtrey and Common Daughtrey the first party to this Indenture do for ourselves and each of our heirs from hereafter now and defende the right and title of the said Bond or the three acres of Land before described which may be the final result and annulment of said Bond against ourselves and each of our heirs and also all and every person and persons whatsoever to know the said Reubin Whitfield and his heirs and assigns forever.
