This Indenture made and entered into this 13 day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty three between William Crumpler of the first part, Walter G. Riddle of the second part and John Argus of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia do hereby certify that the said William Crumpler for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars and nine cents which said sum came from the said William Crumpler to the said John Argus by bond bearing date the 13th day of March one thousand eight hundred and twenty three as well as all other monies which may be due and owing from the said William Crumpler to the said John Argus by means of any dealings Transfer of debt or paper whatever as also for and in consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Walter G. Riddle the receipt whereof the said William Crumpler doth hereby acknowledge to go half granted conveyed and sold and by these presents doth hereby grant bargain and sell convey and make over unto the said William G. Riddle and his heirs forever all his right and interest in the following property to wit: One acre by by the name of Riddle's belonging to him the said William Crumpler to have and to hold with all the right and interest of the said William Crumpler therein conveyed or intended to be conveyed to him the said Walter G. Riddle his heirs and assigns forever upon this special Trust notwithstanding that the said Walter G. Riddle upon being thereto required by the aforesaid John Argus shall proceed to sell all the right and interest of the said William Crumpler to the above named property hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed after advertising the time and place in the said County of Southampton for ten days previous at some publick house or store for cash: and out of the money arising out of from the said sale in the first place pay and satisfy all cost attending the said sale as well as the expenses attending the said conveyance and then pay off the bond aforesaid with interest as well as all other monies which may appear to be due and owing from the said William Crumpler to the said John Argus by means of any dealings Transfer of debt or paper whatever and the surplus of any pay to the said William Crumpler and the said William Crumpler for himself his heirs Executors and administrators the right and title of the said property herein conveyed with the said Walter G. Riddle his heirs and assigns forever doth hereby warrant and defend against the lawful claims or claims of him the said William Crumpler his Executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever: And the said Walter G. Riddle on his part covenants and agrees that he will make satisfaction of the right and interest hereby conveyed for the best price he can obtain for the same after advertising the time and place for ten days previous at some publick house or store on the said County and with the monies arising from the said sale pay and satisfy all cost attending the same as well as the expenses attending the conveyance and then pay off the aforesaid bond and interest as well as all other monies which may appear to be due and owing from the said William Crumpler to the said John Argus by means of any dealings Transfer of debt or paper whatever and then pay the surplus of any to the said William Crumpler: And the said Walter G. Riddle on his part covenants and agrees that he will release the said William Crumpler from the obligation of this incumbrance upon the said William Crumpler paying him the amount of the aforesaid bond with interest as well as all other monies which may be due and owing to him from the said William Crumpler by means of any dealings Transfer of debt or paper whatever.
