This Indenture made and entered into the 23rd day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty three between John Westbrook And Mary his wife of the County of Southampton State of Virginia of the one part And John Turner of County And State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and eighty dollars to me in hand paid by the said Johnathan Turner the receipt whereof need not be set forth or made as full payment And satisfaction hath bargained sold and conveyed unto the said Johnathan Turner One certain tract or parcel of land Situate And being in the County of Southampton On the east side of the flat swamp containing by late survey thirty six acres (or the same more or less) And bounded as follows Beginning at a small old pine tree in which Thomas has running a 77 or 33 poles to the person in trees near a corner of a ditch thence along the ditch 144 10 poles to a Key in a branch thence down the branch to a small Gum thence 157 or 107 poles to a Gum and then back on the run of the flat swamp thence down the run of the flat swamp to a corner then thence along Miller Francis line 133 or 58 poles to a white Oak thence 122 or 6 poles to the first Station to have And a hole the said tract or parcel of land together with all the appurtenances thereof from and after the executing and delivery hereof in witness whereof and in presence of by from And Between of their friends into the said Johnathan Turner his heirs assigns forever to him And their heirs forever use And behoof in as large Use Ample a manner as for the said John Westbrook his wife or any other person or persons might or might enjoy Claiming under us In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals this day and date above written signed sealed and delivered in presence of John C.
