

Witnessed and acknowledged before me this 15th day of November in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and twenty three between
 Martens Tom, Patrick Tond and William Ricks Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Southampton to sell a
 certain part of the Lands of Nathaniel Kitchens dec: for the purpose of paying a certain debt due Henry Bragg of the County
 aforesaid and also to pay the expenses of the same as well as the survey and division of said land together with all the
 expenses that has or shall have accrued thereon of the one part and Thomas Gray of said County who became
 the purchaser of said Land of the other part witnesseth that the said Martens Tom, Patrick Tond and William
 Ricks Commissioners as aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars Virginia
 money to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Gray hath granted bargained sold alured bargained and confirmed
 and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Gray for him and his assigns forever one certain
 tract or parcel of the lands of Nathaniel Kitchens dec: containing thereto one acre to the same more or less bounded as
 follows: Beginning at an Apple tree near corner made in the ridge done thereof to lot 1011 side to a scrub
 white oak bush in the corner of James West fence which is made a new corner of Captain Thomas Gray's & James West
 Thence along James West Line lot 123 to a point of a small oak a corner of James West at the head
 of St. Mesh line thence along Mesh line lot 111 to a red oak a corner of Capt. Thomas Gray near the
 road called Plover Road at the head of a small branch thence down the various courses of said branch to the intersection
 of this branch and the Spring branch thence down the various courses of the Spring branch to a small black
 Gum standing on the run of said branch a new corner made in the ridge taken done thence along the
 lower line of new marked trees A 10 E 20 pole and A 15 N 25 pole to the first station together with all lands out
 houses Edifices buildings yards gardens orchards may mow and make courses whatsoever belonging or in anywise
 appertaining to the said parcel of Land and premises to have and to hold the same unto the said Thomas
 Gray to have and to his heirs forever and the said Martens Tom, Patrick Tond and William Ricks Commis-
 saries as aforesaid for themselves their heirs Executives and assigns both by these presents warrant and grant
 to and will the said Thomas Gray his heirs and assigns that they shall by these presents have warrant and defend
 all right title claim or demand of any person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof
 as far as the power of indemnification extends to us as Commissioners to warrant and defend and no further to certify
 whereby the said Martens Tom, Patrick Tond and William Ricks hath granted the said lands as and affirmed the
 same this day and date written above

 Clark and Alison Buck and Barbara his wife attorneys of the County of Southampton and Patrick Robertson Attorney
 of the one part and Robertson Clark of the same County and Town of the other part witnesseth that the
 said Robertson Clark for and wife Patrick and Nancy hold to and Alison Buck and Barbara his wife in
 for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars Good Money of Virginia to them in hand paid by
 the said Robertson Clark the receipt whereof the said Robert Davis and Patrick his wife Nancy and Nancy & the
 Buck and wife are for both acknowledge themselves failed and bankrupts and have hath granted bargained sold
 Alured bargained and confirmed and by these presents hath granted bargained and sold unto the said Robertson Clark
 One certain tract or parcel of Land and premises situate described and being in the County aforesaid containing estimation
 duly agreed to the same more or less And bounded as follow: First Beginning at Eddie's Cabin Line and thence along
 the line to John Denny line and also bounded by River 19 and line and River 13 and thence down thence round to
 the first station together with all houses Edifices buildings yards gardens orchards fruit trees and makes courses
 whatsoever belonging to in any wise appertaining to have and to hold the said Land with all the right
 and title to have the same Robertson Clark being to him and his heirs forever and then the said Robert
 Davis and wife Ans Nancy Clark and Alison Buck and wife etc for themselves their debt by
