This Indenture made and entered into this the 25th day of May in the year of our Lord Christ One thousand and twenty three between John D. Host of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and William Hill of the same County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said John D. Host for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and five dollars current money of this Commonwealth to him on hand paid by the said William Hill at or before the making of the delivery of these presents the full receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargain'd and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain sell unto him the said William Hill and his heirs or assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Patrick containing by the survey one hundred and one acres by the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a small brook here standing in the line between North Carolina and Virginia a corner of said William Hill land John Thoms and a run corner of said John D.
