And whereas in trust execution of the said tract and by virtue of the power and authority written in them by the said Mollers Deed And also in conformity to instructions received pursuant to authority granted by said Deed on the twentieth day of March at this Court aforesaid proceeded to sell to the highest bidder at auction having given the Notice by the said Deed requiring the said tract or parcel of Land estimated as before mentioned to contain Ninety three acres to the same more or less when sold and parcel of the County of Surry aforesaid became the purchaser for the sum of forty five dollars. This Indenture made the tenth day of August one thousand Eight hundred and twenty three between the said Joseph Barham Trustee as aforesaid of the One part and Mollers Part of the County of Surry of the other part witnesseth that the said Joseph Barham Trustee as aforesaid has in consideration of the premises & of the sum of forty five dollars current money of Virginia to him delivered in hand paid also before the execution of and delivery of these presents hath granted Bargained and sold by those premises unto the said Joseph Barham and doth unto the said Islands Part His heirs and assigns forever all the Estate right title interest claim and demand whatsoever both at Law and Equity which he the said Joseph Barham hath in or over the before mentioned tract to the said tract or parcel of Land and its Appurtenances Estimated as before at Ninety three acres of Land in the same manner or less to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land aforesaid intended to be conveyed together with all and singular thinges thereon and appertaining unto the said Islands Part His heirs and assigns forever from the time of this the said Joseph Barham as Trustee aforesaid and his heirs and of all and every other person or persons whomever claiming by, through or under him notwithstanding whereof the said Joseph Barham Trustee aforesaid hath herunto set his hand and seal the tenth day of August 1823 depredated sealed and

This Indenture made and entered into this the 20th day of May in the year of our Lord Christ One Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty three between John D. Hart of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and William Hill of the same County and State of the other part witnesseth that the said John D. Hart for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and Five dollars current money of this Commonwealth to him in hands paid by the said William Hill at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents the full receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted Bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant Bargain sell unto him the said William Hill and his heirs and assigns forever more certain tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of West Packard containing by a side survey one hundred and one acres to the same more or less bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a small wood tree standing in the line between John Hart's land and Original corner of said William Hill's land John Rose and a run corner of said John D.
