This Indenture made the 25th day of May in the year of our Lord 1722 Between Jesse Williams the debtor of the first part Joseph Williams Trustee of the second part and Harrison Griffen Creditor of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesses that the said Jesse Williams for and in Consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Harrison Griffen at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged as well as for the further sum of of the said Jesse Williams being justly indebted unto the said Harrison Griffen on the just and full sum of two hundred Dollars due by note which the said Jesse Williams is willing more effectually to secure to the said Harrison Griffen and which in fact is the sole object of these presents hath granted bargained sold conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell & convey and confirm unto the said Harrison Griffen his heirs Executors and administrators the following property namely four three feather &c as three thornes Casse and fourteen bars of Log half dozen black walnut sitting chairs and all my kitchen furniture and the remainder of my property and the said Harrison Griffen his heirs Executors adm or assigns but upon this special condition that the said Harrison Griffen his heirs Executors adm or assigns shall make sale of the above named property at public Auction for the best price which can be obtained for the same after advertising the time and place for selling the same ten days previous notice to the said Sheriff at the Court house door of the said County of Southampton and at as many other places as he the said Harrison Griffen may think proper and with the money arising from said sale shall first pay to the said Harrison Griffen the aforesaid sum of two hundred dollars with the legal interest thereon and all other legal claims which the said Harrison Griffen may have against the said Jesse Williams together with all costs attending the executing and selling same and then pay the surplus if any to the said Jesse Williams his heirs Executors adm or assigns and the said Jesse Williams for himself his heirs Executors adm or assigns this title unto the aforesaid mentioned property unto the said Harrison Griffen his heirs Executors adm for the purposes aforesaid do warrant and forever defend against the lawful claim or claims of him the said Jesse Williams or any other person or persons whatsoever claiming or demanding the same or any part thereof and the said Harrison Griffen his heirs Executors adm do agree to make sale of the within named property at any time when required by the said Harrison Griffen his heirs Executors and adm after advertising as aforesaid Indenture witness of the parties hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and year within written
