 in hand paid by the said Hanford S. Driffers the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained
 and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Hanford S. Driffers his heirs his assigns
 a certain tract or parcel of Land known by the name of Williams' containing one hundred and fifty acres
 be the same more or less and bounded by the Lands of William Miles Drury Williams and Charles
 Cobb To have and to hold the said Tract or parcel of Land together with all and singular its appurtenances
 to him the said Hanford S. Driffers and his heirs forever and the said Thomas Patton and Jane W.
 his wife their heirs heirs and assigns the said Tract or parcel of Land with its appurtenances to him
 the said Hanford S. Driffers his heirs and assigns their heirs and assigns forever. In witness whereof

This Indenture made this 14th day of July 1723 Between John Richman and Rebecca his wife of the County of
 Southampton of one part and Francis Clements of the said County of the other part Witness that for and consider
 ation of the sum of fourteen hundred dollars to us in hand paid by the said Francis Clements the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged had bargained and sold and these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said
 Francis Clements one certain tract or parcel of Land known by the name of the Marcell plantation containing
 three hundred and twenty five acres be the same more or less lying and being in the County aforesaid
 bounded as follows To wit Beginning at a pine and a locust tree on the road leading from Scotland to
 Redfield a corner of said Land and so by North thence along North line to a pine a corner of Samuel Lord
 and said thence along South line to Herberts Swamp and said Swamp to a pond between said Land
 and George Drury and up the stream of said Pond to a pine in Arthur Williams' land and along said line
 to the Land of Anne Drury dead and along said line to the opposite road and down said Road to the beginning
 with all the benefits and profits thereunto belonging which said Land & the said Richman and Rebecca his wife
 the title of to said Clements and his heirs forever against the claim of every person whatsoever without
 hands and seals this day & date above written signed sealed &
