This Indenture made this 18th day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty three between Thomas Pettet and Jane M^r wife of the County of Southampton and the said Thomas Pettet and Jane M^r wife in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars to him in hand paid by the said Maryon J^r Griffen the receipt whereof a full acknowledgement have made by him and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Maryon J^r Griffen his heirs & assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land situated in the County of Williams containing one hundred and forty acres to be the same more or less and bounded by the Lands of William Wiles Drawy Williams and Thaddeus Cobb to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land together with all and singular its appurtenances to him the said Maryon J^r Griffen and his heirs forever and the said Thomas Pettet and Jane M^r his wife their heirs & assigns the said tract or parcel of Land with its appurtenances to him the said Maryon J^r Griffen his heirs and assigns shall and will forever warrant & defend the said tract or parcel of Land to the said Thomas Pettet and Jane M^r his wife have & receive the same let their Land & seal the day and date above written

This Indenture made this 14th day of July 1823 between John Easton and Petter his wife of the County of Southampton of one part and Francis Clements of the said County of the other part witnesseth that for and consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars to her hands paid by the said Francis Clements the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged both bargained and sold and these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Francis Clements over certain tract or parcel of Land known by the name of the Marcella plantation containing three hundred thirteen and a quarter acres to the same more or less lying and being in the County aforesaid bounded as follows toward Beginning at a pine tree and a locust tree on the road leading from Easton to Petters a corner of said Land and thence along said road to a pine a corner of said Land and said thence along Jones Run to Starbuck's Swamp and said thence to a pond between said Land and George Dray and up the stream of said pond to a pine on Acheson's plantation lies and along thence to the Land of Aaron Hough dead and along said line to the open road and down said road to the beginning with all the benefits and profits thereunto belonging which said Land & the said Easton doth now keep the title of to said Clements and his heirs forever against the claim of every person whatsoever without hands and seals this day & date above written signed sealed &
