This Indenture made and entered into this 15th day of April in the year of our Lord Christ Eighteen hundred and thirty four between Samuel Brown of Southampton Conroy of the first part and Simon Murrell of the said Conroy of the second part witnesseth that for and in consideration of fifteen dollars Law full money of Virginia to him or him paid by him the said Simon Murrell before the executing and delivery of these presents to him the said S. Brown the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said S. Brown hath granted bargain and sold and by these presents grants bargain and sells to him the said S. Murrell his heirs and assigns forever one certain Lot or parcel of land lying and being in the Town of Murrell (containing the parts of an acre be the same more or less) being the last parcel of Land which Thomas Reddell does to Thomas Sand and appears in the map of said Town as last made and said Lot was sold to James Sand to Simon Murrell and by Simon Murrell to William S. Pollard and by Pollard the said Brown but the due was made by the said Reddell to the said Brown to have and to hold the said Lot or parcel of Land with all and every part and parcel thereof to him the said Simon Murrell his heirs and assigns forever free from the claim or claims of him the said S. Brown his heirs or any person or persons whatsoever as witness hereof we the said S. Brown do hereby seal our hands and seals this 15th day of April before written signed sealed &c. in presence of

This Indenture made and entered into this 14th day of March in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand Eight hundred and thirty three by and between Simon Murrell and Lydia his wife of Southampton Conroy Virginia of the first part and Samuel Brown of the same Conroy of the second part witnesseth that for the sum of fifteen dollars Law full money of Virginia to them or them paid by him the said Samuel Brown before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Simon Murrell and Lydia his wife have granted bargain and sold and do by these presents grants bargain and sells to him the said Samuel Brown his heirs and assigns forever Lot or parcels of Land lying and being in the aforesaid Conroy and situate near the Town of Murrell beginning as a Shapins Point a corner of a Lot purchased by Cordiale Whitehead from Edmund Reddell and another party and more fully appears by the deed executed by said Reddell and on record in the Clerks Office of the Conroy running nearly a north course to the old road thence up the said road nearly a west course to the corner of said Murrells farm fence thence to the said Road toward C. S.
