Brown the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said S. Brown hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents grants bargains and sells to him the said S. Morse his heirs and assigns forever one certain Lot or parcel of land lying and being in the Town of Monroe containing the contents of an acre be the same more or less being the late parcel of Land which Benjamin Rodelle sold to Thomas Sand and appeared on the map of said Town as Lot No. 2 and said Lot was sold to James Sand to Simon Morse and by Simon Morse to William S. Pollard and by Pollard to the said Brown but this deed was made by the said Rodelle to the said Brown to have and to hold the said Lot or parcel of Land with all and every part and parcel thereof to him the said Simon Morse his heirs and assigns forever from the claim or claims of him the said S. Brown his heirs or any person or persons whatsoever as witnesses hereunto and that this day and date first before written

This Indenture made and entered into this 14th day of March in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand Eight hundred and thirty three by and between Simon Morse and Lucy his wife of Southampton County Virginia of the first part and Samuel Brown of the said County of the second part witnesses that for the sum of fifteen dollars Law full money of Virginia to them or hand paid by him the said Samuel Brown before the encoding and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Simon Morse and Lucy his wife have granted bargained and sold and do by these presents grants bargains and sells to him the said Samuel Brown his heirs and assigns forever Lot or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County and State and near the Town of Monroe beginning at a Shapins Point a corner of a Lot then shared by Cordiale Whitfield from Edmund Rodelle and then on a right middle more fully appears by the deed Executed by said Rodelle and on record in the Clerk's Office of the County aforesaid nearly a north course to the old road thence up the said road nearly a north course to the corner of said Samuel Brown's place thence as the said Road toward C. L. Mellicum Allen Decker about twenty yards to the road and by from the Thomas Case home thence as the road to a corner of the Shapins Point a corner of the before mentioned Lot purchased by Cordiale Whitfield and thence toward the said Lot to the first black split post to contain the area more or less North to the said Simon Morse and Lucy his wife with rail for themselves their heirs or assigns and all and every person appearing thereunto and as attested by these present over and over before signed all right title claims or interest in said land to him the said Samuel Brown his heirs or assigns forever In testimony whereof on the parties have set our hands and date this said date first before written signed and sealed in presence of
