This Indenture made and entered into this 15th day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty three on and between Jno Thomas of Southampton County one of the one part and Thomas Monro of the same County and State of the second part witnesses that the said Jno Thomas and the said Thomas Monro have swapped one acre of Land lying and being in the above said County and State and in the lower district of Saint Luke Parish the one corner of the said Thomas Monro is an acre which the said Thomas purchased of John Rockwell which unto more fully appear by a Deed executed by Rockwell to him on the 12th of June in the clerk's office in the said County of being a part of a tract of Land which the said Thomas purchased of a certain Elvington & Brown it is nevertheless understood that there is a Lot in the above said which the said Thomas reserves to himself to move off of the one which the said Thomas is to do between this and the 1st day of March 1824 and the said Monro is to give to the said Thomas one half acre lying in the town of House bounded by East Stone a lot due by John Francis to Miles & Smagett Lot and Parker Williams Lot and the lot two conveyed hands on the map of said town as Lot No 10 also one half acre Lot No 35 and bounded by Mrs Livingston about Rockwell says Lot No 36. Now the above parties at each of them bind them and their heirs Executors and assigns by these presents to stand and forever abide the above agreement in the above swap of Land or Lots of Land in and about which the parties have set our hands and fixed our seals this day and date above written

This Indenture made this 25th day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty three between Abner Howell Magrath of the County of Sussex of the one part and James Salton of the other part Witnesseth that the said Abner Howell Magrath by virtue of a Deed of Trust executed to him by the Prince and others for the purpose of securing the payment of a certain debt of money therein mentioned to William Morison bearing date the ninth day of November in the ninth year of the said Prince and others recorded in the clerk's office of the County of Sussex for and consideration of the sum of Eighty nine dollars and thirty seven cents to him or him to be paid the receipt or receipt's duly acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said James Salton his heirs and assigns forever all the right title interest claim or demand of John Prince of or and to a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation sixty three acres be the same more or less and bounded by the Town of Elizabeth Prince William Prince and the Towns of the said James Salton to have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land unto the said James Salton his heirs and assigns forever and the said Abner Howell Magrath for him self and his heirs all the title to the said Land which was conveyed to him by the before mentioned Deed of Trust free from the claim or demand of the said Abner Magrath and of all and every person or persons claiming under him unto the said James Salton his heirs and assigns their and their heirs and assigns and forever defend to their presents In witness whereof the said Abner Howell Magrath hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first above written.
