This Indenture made this 25th day of January in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and twenty three between Samuel Stanton and Martha his wife of the County of Southampton parish of Wallingford and State of Virginia of the one part and Mills Giffen of the same parish County and State of the other late Wifes wife that the said Samuel Stanton and Martha his wife in consideration of the sum of Thirty seven Dollars and fifty Cents of lawful money of the Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Mills Giffen and to her the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Mills Giffen his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County and parish aforesaid containing by estimation two and one half acres to the same and a less and bounded as follows, beginning at a corner tree in Joseph Edwards and Henry Abbotsons lines thence along a line of marked trees to a post into a corner of Joseph Edwards lines thence a line of marked trees to the first stones together with all and singular the houses out houses Edifices Buildings yards gardens orchards fruit trees and water courses with all the profits Commodities hereditaments and appurtenances unto the said land belonging or in any way appertaining to the same or any part or parcel thereof to have and to hold the said lands and one half acre of land with the premises herein before mentioned and every part and parcel thereof unto the said Mills Giffen his heirs and assigns forever to use for the only professe and behoof of him the said Mills Giffen his heirs and assigns forever to one of the said Samuel Stanton and Martha his wife for themselves their heirs the said seven and one half acres of land with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said Mills Giffen his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Samuel Stanton and Martha his wife or either of them their heirs and of all and every other person or persons whatever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents In witness whereof the said Samuel Stanton and Martha his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals this day and year first above written
