This Indenture made this 16th day of August in the year of Our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and forty three between James Parker and Nancy Parker his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Bolling A. Barnes of the same County and State of the other part Testifying that the said James Parker and Nancy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty dollars Current money of the Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Bolling A. Barnes at or before the making of this Indenture of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell after except off from his possession unto the said Bolling A. Barnes and his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Township of Saint Luke containing by a late Survey thereon acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a Post hole a corner of Allen's Woods and a tree commonly called between said Bolling A. Barnes and James Parker there along said Bolling A. Barnes line N 35 E 106 poles to a white oak standing in Jordan Jones line there along Jordan Jones line N 35 W 108 poles to a pine corner of said Jordan Jones and Bolling A. Barnes there along said Bolling A. Barnes line down the west part branch N 45 E 102 1/2 poles to a red oak chance S 75 E 100 poles thence N 75 W 108 poles thence N 35 S 10 to be poles to a small gully running in the run of the said body of land a corner made between said Bolling A. Barnes and James Parker thence along a run line of marked trees S 75 W 100 poles to the first station together with all right title interest claim or demand of an easement to the said tract or parcel of land and promises with the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any case appertaining to have and to hold the said tract of land and promises with its appurtenances unto him the said Bolling A. Barnes and his heirs forever to the only proper use and benefit of him the said Bolling A. Barnes and the said James Estelle and Nancy his wife de fothermises their heirs executors administrators or assigns Covenant to and with the said Bolling A. Barnes his heirs executors administrators or assigns that they will warrant and forever defend the title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and every part thereof thereof against the lawfull claim or claims of all and every person or persons who or whom in witness whereof the said James Parker and Nancy his wife have hereunto interchangably set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first written
