This Indenture made and executed this 25th day of July in the year of Christ eighteen hundred
 and twenty three between Augustin Pope of the County of Southampton of the one part and Robert of
 Barres of the said County and State of King's of the other part Witnesseth that the said James
 Parton of the said County and State of King's bearing date the 17th day of December 1521 and recorded on the County
 Court of said County on the 15th day of March 1522 did convey unto the said Augustin Pope as Trustee
 certain tract of land therein particularly described and mentioned containing thirty ten and one acre
 the said Augustin Pope hath as he was enjoined and requested by the said Barres after advertising the same
 as required by him published notice of the place and terms of selling the land unto the said Barres at
 Subbills sale where the said Robert of Barres became the purchaser of the piece of one
 hundred and twenty eight acres Now this Indenture further witnesseth that whereas for and in
 consideration of other circumstances aforesaid as well for and in consideration of the sum of one
 hundred and twenty eight Pounds current money of this Commonwealth to him the said Augustin
 Pope in hand paid by the said Robert of Barres the receipt whereof the said Augustin Pope
 hath duly acknowledged he the said Augustin Pope doth hereby give grant bargain sell
 unto the said Robert of Barres his heirs and assigns the said tract of land lying being with
 being aforesaid and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a Post or stake corner of Allens field in
 James Nicholls land 1520 E 37 poles to a green pine thence N 77 E 36 poles thence N 75 E 36 poles
 thence N 79 E 36 poles to a pine thence N 74 E 36 poles to a green pine corner of James Nicholls
 in Augustin Popes land thence along said Popes land N 59 W 28 poles to a green pine thence
 through the fence along Jordan Rogers land to a white oak a new course made between the
 said Robert of Barres and James Parton in Jordan Rogers land of new marked trees be
 the course of said line to the beginning containing thirty ten and one acre it being part of the tract
 of land which the said James Parton now lives and purchased of said Robert of Barres who
 now disposes of at Subbills sale as aforesaid together with the appurtenances thereto belonging now
 and of future having to have and to hold the said tract of land and hereby conveyed to the only proper
 use and behoof of the said Robert of Barres his heirs and assigns forever and the said Augustin
 Pope doth warrant aforesaid the said tract of land hereby conveyed together with its appurtenances
 to the said Robert of Barres his heirs and assigns against the claim of the said Augustin Pope
