This Indenture made this 5th day of February 1819 between Anna Turner of the County of Southampton
town of the one part James Scott of the said County of the second part and Joseph Trotter of the said County of
Southampton of the third part WITNESSETH that whereas the said Anna Turner stands greatly indebted
by bond to the said James Scott in the sum of three hundred and fifty four dollars Current money
of the United States of America and whereas for the further appearance of the payment it is agreed
the parties hereto that as compensation in trust shall be made to the said Joseph Trotter for the sum
of the said James Scott in case the sum on the said bond shall not be punctually paid such
sum shall interest thereon on or before the 5th day of October next after this Indenture WITNESSETH
the said Anna Turner for and unconditioned of the premises and for other further sum for
one dollar to him in hand paid the receipt of which is acknowledged to have been and is
set out by this present instrument his heirs and administrator give grant bargained sold and
the said Joseph Trotter his heirs and assigns one hundred and thirty three acres both more
and less bounded according to the known and reputed boundaries also a plantation Messingay tract
and parcels of land situated in Smith Hampton County above Containery by estimation
Ninety acres more or less and is all the land which the said Mrs Turner brought of Seton
