This Indenture made the 29<sup>th</sup> day of April one thousand eight hundred and twenty three between John T.  
Blair Thomas Fitzhugh, Benjamin Colb and Jeremiah Colb of the Mettaway tribe of Indians of the one part and  
James Tregant of the second part and Henry B. Vaughan of the third part. Whereas the said Henry B. Vaughan  
by his deed dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of March 1820 and admitted to record in the Court of Southampton County March  
1820 in the same year in order to secure the payment of the bene then specified of the sum of two hundred & eighty  
one dollars due March 5<sup>th</sup> 1821 the further sum of two hundred and eighty one dollars due March 5<sup>th</sup> 1822 and the  
further sum of two hundred dollars due March 5<sup>th</sup> 1823 owing by him the said Henry B. Vaughan to the said John  
Thomas Blair, Thomas Fitzhugh, Benjamin Colb and Jeremiah Colb, trustees as aforesaid conveyed in trust  
to the said James Tregant a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton the same being  
a part of land authorized by an act of the General Assembly to be sold by the said trustees belonging to the said  
Indians reserved from the said said trustees due to said Vaughan's debt, appear fully and the aforesaid several  
sums were mentioned having been fully paid by the said Henry B. Vaughan to the said John T. Blair, Thomas  
Fitzhugh, Benjamin Colb and Jeremiah Colb, trustees as aforesaid, in the said Henry B. Vaughan's hands  
request that the Estate conveyed by the said deed of trust to him the said James Tregant in the said tract of  
land be now released to him the said Henry B. Vaughan. This Indenture therefore witnessed that for and  
in consideration of One dollar by the said Henry B. Vaughan to the said James Tregant in hand paid  
before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt taking of a happy & solemn legal by the said James  
Tregant with the consent of the said John T. Blair, Thomas Fitzhugh, Benjamin Colb & Jeremiah Colb  
has been aforesaid signified by their being parties thereto have granted, remitted, released and forever quit claimed  
and by these presents do fully and absolutely grant, remitted, released and forever quit claim unto the said Henry  
B. Vaughan his heirs and assigns forever all the estate, right, title, interest, perfecting claim and demand whatsoever  
in law or equity of him the said James Tregant of or to the aforesaid tract of land with its appurtenances to the said Henry B. Vaughan  
his heirs and assigns in the only proper use and behoof of the said Henry B. Vaughan his heirs and assigns forever  
so that the said James Tregant nor his heirs nor any other person whatsoever claiming under him shall  
by any way or means hereafter claim or demand any estate, right, title or interest of or to the said  
premises or any part or parcel thereof whatsoever in which respect of the parties of the first & second  
parts of these presents have heretofore set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year last herein
