Carrytow This Indenture made this 15th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty, shew between John Carr and Sally Carr his wife of the first part and Jacob Williams of the other part witnesseth that for and consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars to have the said John Carr in hand paid at and before the making and delivery of these presents by the said Jacob Williams the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said John Carr and Sally his wife have granted bargained and sold alight and confirmed by these presents do grant bargain and sell alien and transfer unto the said Jacob Williams his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a pine tree standing in John Mardenrods line thence North West. Counting along a line of Market trees all in John Mardenrods line to a fence at corner of John Bradens lands standing on the side of Barren Roads thence along the said Barren Roads to a Meadow and a corner of Henry B. Vaughan Nobreca Darden and Jacob Williams their neigbor both having a straight line to a black oak & corner of Simon Tops land standing in Jacob Williams line thence down said Tops line to the head of Williams line thence down it various courses of said branch to a small Turkey oak standing immediately on the side of said branch thence North East comes a straight line to the first station containing by estimate survey made by Samuel W. Moore Surveyor One hundred and fifty acres to be the same moreover with its appurtenances which comprehend one over apple orchard 6. 3. have and to hold the said bargained premises to him the said Jacob Williams his heirs and assigns forever and to the sole and only proper use benefit and behoof of him the said Jacob Williams his wife and assigns forever and they the said John Carr and Sally his wife for themselves their heirs executors etc. these presents warrant and will forever warrant and defend the said bargained premises against the lawful claim or demands of all and all manner of persons whatsoever to have the said Jacob Williams his heirs and assigns forever.
