This Indenture made this 15th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty three between John Carr and Sally Carr his wife of the one part and Jacob Williams of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars to him the said John Carr in hand paid at our Office as hereby acknowledged they the said John Carr and Sally his wife have granted conveyed sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain and sell alien and confirm unto the said Jacob Williams his heirs and assigns forever an certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a pine tree standing in John Underwoods line thence North North West Course along the line of marked trees all the John Underwoods line to a corner tree of John Underwoods land standing on the side of Pleasant Road thence along the line of Pleasant Road to a corner tree of Henry B. Baughmans Rebecca Baughman and Jacob Williams thence nearly South Course a straight line to a black oak corner of Simon Toppers land thence along the line of said Toppers land to the head of Williams line thence down the various courses of said branch to a small nut tree oak standing immediately on the side of said branch thence North East course a straight line to the first station containing by plat survey made by Thomas Worrell surveyor one hundred and twenty five acres be the same more or less unto the appurtenances which comprehends one good apple orchard abt. 75. have and to hold the said bargained premises to him the said Jacob Williams his heirs and assigns forever and to the sole and only proper use benefit and behoof of him the said Jacob Williams his heirs and assigns forever and they the said John Carr and Sally his wife for themselves their heirs Executors and assigns these presents warrant and well forever warrant and defend the said bargained premises against the lawful claim or demands of all and all manner of persons whatsoever to him the said Jacob Williams his heirs and assigns forever.
