This Indenture made this 25th day of November in the year 1823 between William Wm of the one part and Henry Emley of the other part both of the town of Southampton and County of Southampton. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the just and full sum of Eighty three dollars and thirty three and one fourth cents by the said Henry Emley to the said William Wm in hand paid at or before the executing and delivering thereof the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Have granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Henry Emley his heirs and assigns forever one third of one sixth part of a tract of land adjoining the town of Southampton being part of the land which Robert and Adam purchased of Enoch Scott their said to late Samuel Wells Community called the Court house tract and divided as follows. Beginning at the first of the line of the lot specified and by John J. Wm. half near the grave yard thence back by a small white oak in a hand line through the old field to a small crooked pine on the edge of another hand line through the hand line and kind of marked tree on the edge of cleared ground to a large pine a corner of the land formerly owned by Captain Vick purchased from Enoch Scott from thence about thirty or fifty yards further to a large the pine period corner of the cleared ground thence near a right angle to a corner to a large tree near a slash from thence five the side of the slash to a live oak a corner from thence a straight line more or less right angle to the upper corner formerly between Harts lot from thence along the back line formerly Harts lot back thence lot William bond line lot and Samuel Wells to the first station which bounded same supposed to be late of the Contam Town area for the same more or less also one third of one sixth part of his lots in the town of Jerusalem St. 18 379 formerly owned by Col. Saml Wells. To have and to hold the said lands and lots above described and hereby intended to be granted and sold with its appurtenances together with all due witnesses and mortgages touching or in any way concerning the same to the said Henry Emley his heirs and assigns forever of the said William Wm his heirs &c. the said tract or parcel of land and its appurtenances and to his grants and sold with its appurtenances unto him the said Henry Emley his heirs &c. and against all and every other person or persons claiming by force or under trust do, shall and will warrant and forever defend.
