This Indenture made this 26 day of November in the year 1823 between William Blk<sup>r</sup> of the one part  
and Henry Burley of the other party heret<sup>o</sup> mentioned to the town of Islington and County of London above described  
that for and in consideration of the just and full sum of £800<sup>00</sup> these dators and trustees are about  
ente by the said Henry Burley to the said William Blk<sup>r</sup> in hand paid also before the entering and delivery of  
these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Have granted bargained and sold and by these presents  
doth grant bargained and sell unto the said Henry Burley his heirs and assigns forever one third of said  
sixth part of a half of acre land parcel of land adjoining the Town of Islington being part of the land  
which Hunt and Adams purchased of Ewan Scott then sold to Col<sup>r</sup> Samuel Helle Commoner called  
the Court house tract and bounded as follows Only beginning at the post at the line of the lot first  
ente by Peter J Blk<sup>r</sup> being near the garden gate thence back by a double white oak on a board  
lined through the old field to a small Crooked pine on the edge of another board through the branchling ad  
kind of marked tree on the edge of cleared ground to a large pine corner of the land formerly owned by Captain  
Web purchased from Ewan Scott from thence about thirty or forty yards further to a large Sycamore pine  
corner of the cleared ground thence near a right angle to a corner to a large tree near a  
slash from thence up the side of the slash to a lime, cut a corner from thence a straight line more right  
angle to the upper corner formerly Mrd<sup>r</sup> Helle lot from thence along the back line formerly Helle  
lot Col<sup>r</sup> Helle's lot William Blk<sup>r</sup> and Samuel Helle to the first station which bounds  
were supposed to be laid off to Col<sup>r</sup> Helle ten acres to the same more or less also one third  
of one sixth part of the lots in the Town of Islington Bldgs 18 & 19 formerly owned by Col<sup>r</sup> Samuel  
Helle to have and to hold the said land and lots above described and hereby intended to be  
granted and sold unto the aforesaid Henry Burley his heirs and assigns forever of  
the said William Blk<sup>r</sup> his heirs of the said tract or parcel of land and lots hereunder  
also to be granted and sold unto the aforesaid Henry Burley  
his heirs &c and against all and every other person or persons claiming by force or under色
