

Wm Mason Syner and Lucy Syner in Consideration of the sum of one dollar to them on hand paid by the said John Thomas the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged him granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said John Thomas his heirs and assigns forever the following negroes to wit One negro woman named Syner boys Parker Cook and Sam together with their future increase to have and to hold the aforesaid four negroes with their increase as aforesaid unto him the said John Thomas his heirs and assigns to the city proper use and behoof of him the said John Thomas his heirs and assigns forever and the said Elizabeth Syner Martha Syner Mason Syner and Lucy Syner for themselves their heirs Executors and administrators do Covenant and agree to and with the said John Thomas that they will from time and at all times forever hereafter unrevoked and irrevoked the title of the aforesaid four negroes with their increase as aforesaid unto the said John Thomas his heirs and assigns forever upon Special Trust and Confidence nevertheless and to and for the use intents and purposes following that is to say that the said John Thomas at any time hereafter when he shall be thereto requested by either of the parties make sale of the aforesaid four negroes together with their future increase at publick Auction or in any other way he shall be sufficient to pay and satisfy the aforesaid debt entered and costs first going publick Auction at least ten days of the time and place of such sale for ready money and out of the proceeds of such sale pay unto the said John Spencer and Lewis Woodell the aforesaid sum of one hundred and twenty three dollars money Count and forty seven shillings seven pence together with the growing interest thereon and the surplus of any payment the said Elizabeth Syner Martha Syner Mason Syner and Lucy Syner or their order. This Indenture made and entered into this 17th day of November one thousand eight hundred and thirty three between James Taylor Edwards of Southampton County of the first part and James Munroe of the same County of the second and Samuel Moberly of the same County of the third part witnesses James Taylor Edwards the above named Taylor Edwards hands just indented unto the said James Munroe Witnesses to the old name of James C. Edwards and the children of him the said Taylor Edwards in the first specific sum of three hundred and fifty dollars and for which sale appear by former says date bearing equal date with these presents and made payable from the date hereof and also stands partly satisfied with him the said James Munroe for which sale appear by former says date bearing equal date with these presents and made payable as follows to wit on the 25th of December 1834 for the sum of twelve dollars and ten thirds also and for the same sum made payable December 25th 1835 and one made payable for the same sum 25th Decr 1836 and for the Consideration of the above premises but more especially for the sum of one dollar on hand paid unto the said Taylor Edwards by him the said James Moberly before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Taylor Edwards have granted bargained and sold and do by these presents give grant bargain and sell to him the said James Moberly his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in Southampton County and being a part of said tract called
