Bailey his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said James C. Bailey his heirs and assigns forever and the said Henry Barker for himself his heirs doth hereby Command promise and agree to and with the said James C. Bailey his heirs and assigns in manner and form following that is to say that the said Henry Barker his heirs and assigns doth hereby convey unto the said James C. Bailey his heirs and assigns against all persons whatever shall and law warrant and power defend by their presents before Special Jury or Conference Nevertheless that the said James C. Bailey his heirs executors administrators or assigns shall permit the said Henry Barker to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the aforesaid property and take the proper thing to his own use and unless default is made in the execution of the said Henry Barker to the said Richard Henry Nor individually the said Thomas Hunt and Benjamin Relfor are or may be liable to sustain damage and then upon this further Trust that the said James C. Bailey his executors administrators or assigns shall and will do so as any damages are likely in his opinion (or in the opinion of either of the parties to these presents to be sustained by the said Thomas Hunt and Benjamin Relfor or either of them in consequence of their Secretaryship for the said Secretaryship aforesaid at the request of either of them their heirs executors and assigns or at the request of the said Henry Barker proceed to sell to the highest bidder for ready money at public auction all the property herein before granted having previously advertised the time and place of the sale of the same in some Newspaper printed in the Town of Petersburg for one month successively and out of the proceeds of the sale of the same in the first place pay and satisfy all Costs and charges attending the complete execution of the Trust and then the amount of damages and Costs which may be likely to be sustained by the said Thomas Hunt and Benjamin Relfor in consequence of their Secretaryship aforesaid with legal interest thereon in case any award is awarded or occurs and the balance of any pay over to the said Henry Barker his heirs executors administrators or assigns In Witness whereof the parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above written
