To all to whom these presents shall come *James Donnell* of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and *John Donnell* of the said County and State of the other part *Witnesseth* that the said *James Donnell* for natural love and affection that he hath and beareth to and for his son *John Donnell* by these presents doth give and grant unto him a tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and State of Virginia containing by estimation one hundred and five acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a corner in the quarter Sept line thence along the said Sept line Southward to James and well by the Sept line to the Express Swamp or by a new corner line thence along my old line to the Sun thence to a fork in the line thence thenceward across the old tract by Station together with some sand woods, Mowed orchards and wing fields and appurtenances thenceward belonging or in any way appurtenant unto the said *John Donnell* his heirs and assigns during my natural life and after my death doth give grant and confirm unto him and his heirs forever the simple the above mentioned tract of land houses, orchards and wing appurtenances and thenceward belonging or in any way appurtenant unto the said *John Donnell* his heirs and assigns forever the said *James Donnell* his heirs and assigns forever the said *James Donnell* for myself my heirs and assigns and all other person or persons doth hereby warrant and defend the said agreement during life and after the given granted and confirmed bargain for the said tract of land of houses together with all the appurtenances thenceward belonging free and clear from the just title claim or demand of either of us or of any of us unto the said *John Donnell* his heirs and assigns forever to which whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this ninth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and one being then signed sealed acted and duly witnessed of us

This Indenture made this day of in the year of our Lord 1824 between *Charles Lawrence* of the County of Southampton of the one part and *John Lawrence* of the State of Massachusetts and County of Northampton of the other part *Witnesseth* that the said *Charles Lawrence* for and in consideration of the sum of Commits and agreements hereafter in and by these presents mentioned reserves and continues in the part and behalf of the said *John Lawrence* his Executors administrators to be paid observed and done and performed both grants demands leases and to farm better and by these presents doth lease and to farm let unto the said *John Lawrence* his Executors and assigns all that plantation tract or parcel of land and premises including the manse house and wharves Thomas Lawrence p. m. land and which was the former residence of the Lawrence did and continuing by recent survey 120 acres more or less and singular the appurtenances unto the said *John Lawrence* his Executors and assigns from the 25th day of December next ensuing the day of the date of these presents for and during and until the full end and term of five years from thence next ensuing and fully to be complete and ended yielding and paying therefor at the expiration of said term the sum of one hundred dollars and also to make the necessary improvements to wit make and hang two new doors and planks the floor, in a neat and workmanlike manner and enclose the plantation aforesaid with a good and lawful fence and that the said *John Lawrence* his Executors and assigns shall and will from time to time and at all times hereafter during the said term of five years here before granted at his and their own proper costs and charges and sufficiently repair and maintain and keep the said demised premises with their and every of their appurtenances belonging to the same in by and with all manner of repair and necessary repairs and amendments when and as often as the same shall require (damages by fire only excepted) at the
