This Indenture made the 31st day of May 1819 one thousand eight hundred and twenty three between Richard Harrison jr of the one part John Wornack of the second part and Thomas S Smith of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witness that the said Richard Harrison Junr in order to secure and indemnify the said John Wornack against any damages that he may sustain as done by the said Richard Harrison jr for the maintenance of a debt now depending and undetermined between the said Richard Harrison jr and Benjamin Harrison in the County Court of Southampton in a case of forcible entry and detainer and from which the said Richard Harrison had taken an appeal to the Superior Court of Law to be holden in and for the County of Southampton on or near the second day of June next and in pursuance of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Thomas S Smith which is hereby acknowledged to the said Richard Harrison jr have granted bargain and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Thomas S Smith his executor heirs and assigns the following property to wit one negro or man named Lydia a black and furnished one prop one side board four chest and two quills Blankets unto him the said Thomas S Smith his Executors administrators and assigns forever upon that receipt and upon express Condition that if he the said Richard Harrison jr his heirs heirs or assigns shall sell and (buy) pay or Cause to be paid unto the said John Wornack his heirs heirs or assigns any and all damages that he the said John Wornack may sustain as aforesaid then the said Thomas S Smith shall execute proper and legal releases for the purpose hereby conveyed that is agreed by the parties and it is declared to be the true intent and meaning of the parties the former and the said Richard Harrison jr Covenant and agree with the other parties hereto that in case the said Richard Harrison jr shall fail to pay to the said John Wornack the any and all damages that he (may) sustain as aforesaid then the said Richard Harrison jr as aforesaid that when the said Thomas S Smith his Executors or assigns shall at the request of the said John Wornack his heirs heirs or assigns the after giving an order of the time and place of the sale of the property aforesaid fifteen days previous thereto proceed to sell the same to the highest bidder for the highest price that can be obtained out of the money arising

in full for the sum of one dollar
