thereof of Hugh Craig, who personally before me the said John C. Sullivan an acting Justice
of the Peace for the aforesaid District in the state of South Carolina and made with that he
is also with John Evans witness the due execution of the said agreement and together with
a certificate of John Craig Clerk of the aforesaid district certifying that John C.
Sullivan is a Justice of the Peace of the said district and that due faith and credit ought to be
placed in all his official acts as such together with an agreement whereby from John
Humphries to Alexander J. Tots and also the acknowledgement of the said agreement
before W. H. Marshall a Justice of the Peace for Wake County N. C. Carolina and together
with another certificate of B. C. King Clerk of the County Court of Pleas and Quarter Session
for the County aforesaid certifying that W. H. Marshall is a Justice of the Peace for
said County and that due faith and credit ought to be placed in all his official acts
as such and a witness to record And at a Court held for the aforesaid County of Wake
on the 19th January 1824 This Indenture's certificate and payment aforesaid

of the sum of One thousand dollars to me in hand paid by John Humphries of said
State and Union District the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge hand bargained
and sold quiet claims and by these presents do bargain sell and quiet claim unto
the before named John Humphries and to his heirs and assigns forever all my right title entries
estate claim and demand both at law and equity and as well as before as in expectancy
of an quiet title to all that farm parcel or tract of land lying and being in the state of Virginia
in Southampton County Containing the hundred and thirty acres more or less
or less lying between the said creeks and Rappahannock bounded by Land of Sarah
Hobblett Nancy Mrs Alexander Tots and James Hobblett being the plantation
whereon I said Prince formerly lived and formerly the property of John Prince died
with all and singularly the hereditaments there belonging in the year 1803
