 by her bearing date the fifteenth day of December one thousand eight hundred and thirty  
 and records in the Clerk's Office of the County Court of Southampton as by reference to the  
 Record will more fully appear and all houses goods and movables profits and advantages  
 whatsoever to the said tract of Land belonging or in any wise appertaining that may or might  
 have been laid off to the said John Watts or the said John Champlin as then or either of them eighth  
 interest claim and demand in and to the said tract or parcel of Land and the revenues revenues  
 remain and remainders into profits and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof  
 and all the said eighth part interest property claim and demand whatsoever to them the  
 said John Watts and Mary Williamson his wife on and to the said tract or parcel of  
 Land belonging or in any wise appertaining to them and to their heirs eighth part  
 of the said Land with all the appurtenances thereto belonging unto them the said John  
 Watts his heirs and assigns to the only purpose and effect of them the said George  
 Blinn his heirs and assigns forever and the said John Champlin for himself and his  
 heirs doth covenant to stand unto the said George Blinn his heirs and assigns that  
 the undivided eighth part of the said tract of Land with all and every the appurtenances  
 in and thereunto granted and sold unto them the said George Blinn his heirs and assigns against  
 that in the said John Watts and his heirs title forever covenant and defend unto them  
 the said George Blinn his heirs and assigns against the claims of any the said John Watts  
 and his heirs and against the claims of any other person person whatsoever lawfully
